Event Overview

1. Blue Mental Health

The power of water in bringing peace and tranquillity while promoting healing within one's mind and body. Participants will experience firsthand the soothing effects of water, fostering mental well-being.

2. Code of Conduct on the Water

Educating water users on the importance of complying with the code of conduct, respecting other water users, as well as the plants and animals that inhabit these waters. This ensures a safe and harmonious environment for everyone involved.

3. River Environment and Ecosystem Education

Raising public awareness about the flora and fauna living in and around our riverbanks. By respecting their environment, we can mutually benefit from our daily interactions.

Event Schedule

The event will commence with a Wakening the Dragon ceremony, a powerful start that symbolizes the strength and unity of the participants. This will be followed by the Flower Ceremony, where attendees honour and remember their loved ones who have passed from cancer.

As participants embark on their watery voyage, the public will be invited to partake in an educational walk along the riverbank, concluding with light refreshments at the Gate

Lodge Café. This walk will provide an opportunity to learn about the local ecosystem and the importance of preserving it.

Upon the return of the boats, a closing ceremony will be held, followed by food, beverages and music at The Blue Lagoon. This final gathering offers a moment of reflection and celebration, reinforcing the community spirit and the healing journey experienced throughout the event.
